Note 1: The choir or cantor normally conducts the Responsorial Psalm at all Masses. **Lector 2 reads the Responsorial Psalm** at Masses without a choir or cantor to perform the responsorial psalm. Normally this only occurs at the 0730 Mass.

Please inform Jay Hyland by email (jjhyland@cox.net) or phone (703-704-5285) if you will not be available any weekend during the next schedule period or if you wish to be scheduled at any special Mass. Jay makes out the next schedule one month (four Sundays) in advance.

The next schedule will cover Easter Season (April 11, 2010—May 23, 2010). Think ahead to your plans for family obligations, school vacations, college and school graduations, summer vacations, business travel, etc. and let Jay know if you will not be available at any time during this Easter Season, if you have not already done so.

Once the schedule is published lectors are responsible for getting another lector to replace or trade places with them. Notify Anne Shingler, Director of Liturgy and Music, (anne@gs-cc.org) of changes to the schedule. Informing Anne insures that lectors receive the appropriate liturgy script. The Parish website has a form to notify the parish office of the changes, or you can simply email Anne.
