Note 1: The choir or cantor normally sings the Responsorial Psalm at all Masses. **Lector 1 proclaims the Responsorial Psalm** at Masses without a choir or cantor to sing the responsorial psalm. Normally this only occurs at the 7:30 AM Mass. The Responsorial Psalm is located in the Lectionary immediately following the first reading and is also published with the liturgy script on Good Shepherd's Internet Web Page: <http://www.gs-cc.org>.

Note 2: When there is no cantor, **Lector 2 makes the announcements** from the Ambo immediately following the Prayer After Communion, before the Final Blessing and Dismissal. Normally this only occurs at the 7:30 AM Mass.

Think ahead to your Easter, ski and spring vacations, and school graduation plans.
