Good Shepherd Youth Ministry Scouting Service Projects Guidelines (Eagle and Gold)

Good Shepherd supports the formation of the complete person. We are glad to partner with Scouts and Scouting organizations in support of youth service and leadership programs. The following guidelines will help scouts identify suitable projects and ease the approval process, implementation and completion of projects that truly benefit the Good Shepherd parish community.

Requirements

The Scout must be an active member in the life of the parish, through participation in Youth Ministry programs or other ministries.

Process

1. Scouts will have an initial informational meeting with the Director of Youth Ministry or other assigned representative of the parish as appointed by the Pastor, the Pastoral Associate or the Director of Youth Ministry.
2. Following the meeting the scout will submit a proposal, in writing, 6 months in advance of desired project start date.
3. Upon approval, work days will be scheduled in advance of time in coordination with parish representative.
4. The Scout will be required to submit an updated project report after each work day.
5. Upon completion the Scout will present a project completion report.

Notes and other important information

1. Good Shepherd does not allocate financial support for these service projects.
2. Priority will be given to projects that address Good Shepherd's identified needs.
3. Collection projects of goods or money will not be considered.
