#### **EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE FUNDING**



- **\$50,000** distributed through **Emergency Assistance Funds** (**60% increase** over FY 2019)
- 125 families received assistance (**55 more** familes than FY2019)
- Average donation per family = **\$400 (25% increase** over FY2019)
