We look forward to continuing the work of faith formation in new ways this fall and, as always, we will care for those who are in need.

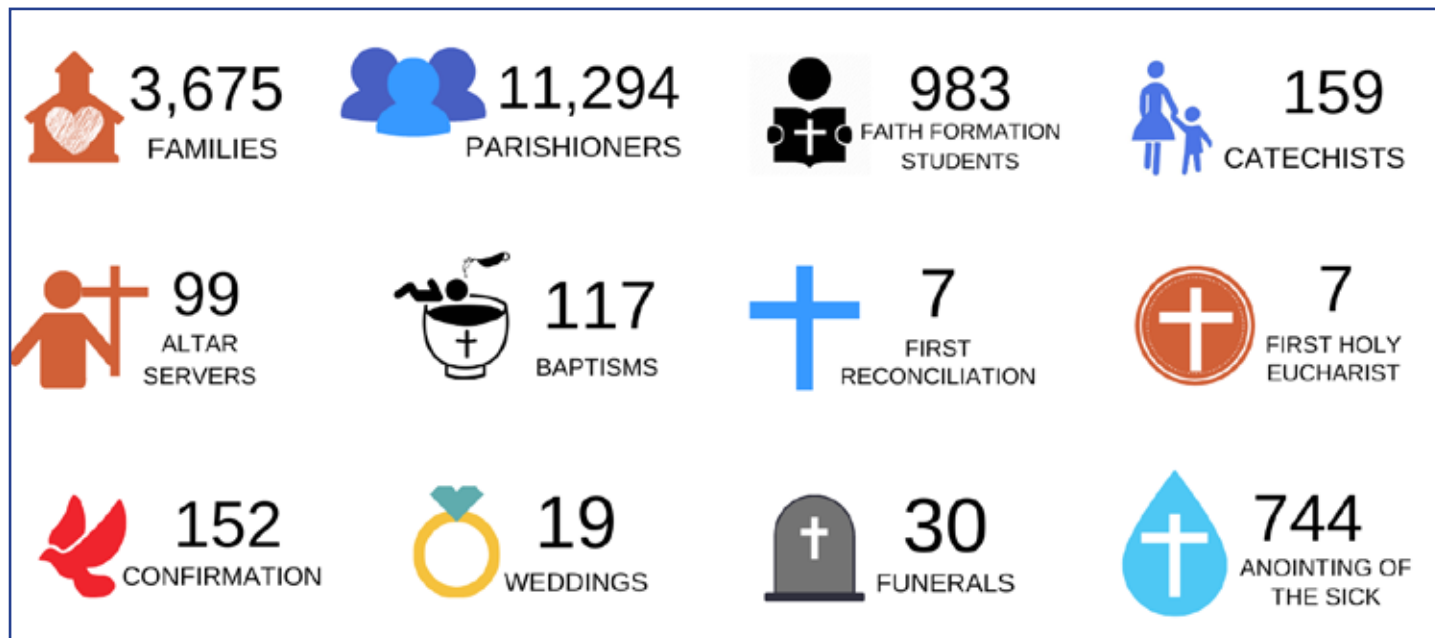
For your spiritual and financial support of our parish, and all whom with your help we serve, once again I say, "Thank you!"

EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE FUNDING



- **\$50,000** distributed through Emergency Assistance Funds (**60% increase** over FY 2019)
- **125 families** received assistance (**55 more families** than FY2019)
- Average donation per family = **\$400 (25% increase** over FY2019)
